

# **La Loma Jr. High - Concert Dress Code** **(For Students)**

Ladies: White Blouse, dress shoes. Black dress slacks are fine. Long Black Skirt, **Absolutely No mini-skirts (skirt must be below the knees) or single-strap tops (shoulders must be covered)**

Gentleman: White Dress shirt, Black Slacks or Dress Pants, Black dress shoes. No tennis shoes

# **La Loma Jr. High - Concert Etiquette** **(For Audience Members)**

## 1. Refrain from Talking

This is the first and greatest rule

## 2. Refrain from unwrapping noisy candy wrappers during the performance

## 3. Turn off pagers, cell phones, and watch alarms

## 4. Please do not wave to your child during the concert

After all your children do know who you are, you most likely brought them to the concert

## 5. Do not take flash photography

This is extremely distracting to other audience members and especially the performers

## 6. Do not leave as soon as your child's portion of the concert is over

All students deserve a full audience for their performances.

## 7. Applaud at appropriate times

Some music may have several sections/movements. Remember it is not over until ALL of the sections/movements have been completed. The Concert Program will identify the pieces of music with multiple sections/movements for you.

## 8. Do not leave the auditorium during the music

Wait for the end of a movement or in between songs. If you are carrying a child please sit near an exit so you can make a quick & discreet exit should the child begin to scream or cause a scene.
